Skills and Qualifications: A Doctor of Veterinary Medicine (DVM) degree, or equivalent, from an accredited university. Licensure in good standing to practice in Illinois and/or Indiana. Professional appearance, with excellent interpersonal skills and a positive, friendly attitude.

The ability to make decisions and communicate clearly and effectively with clients and fellow team members.

Respect for and willingness to work with clients and their pets.

A commitment to practicing the highest standard of medicine, upholding the veterinary code of ethics.

Job Responsibilities: Develop a rapport with clients and determine their needs and wishes; perform physical examinations and diagnostic/medical/surgical/dental procedures in a way that will deliver the highest quality care that a client is willing to provide for their pet while minimizing patient stress and discomfort to create "Fear-Free Visits."

Explain physical examination findings and communicate to the client a diagnosis of the pet's problems; generate and present a healthcare plan for the pet to the client; educate clients on preventive health care, including vaccines and appropriate nutritional products. Be an advocate for the patient while respecting the clients' wishes.

Maintain client/patient medical/surgical records and make certain all necessary logs are kept up-to-date through established protocols; assist colleagues in follow-up and future management of the patient.

Stay up-to-date with new medical information and changes in veterinary medicine, fulfill requirements for attending local Continuing Education meetings and complete at least 20 hours of accredited CE per year.
