1. POLICY:

- 1.1 It is the policy of Ross University to provide facilities for animals, which are Housed on campus and used for teaching purposes.

2. SCOPE

- 2.1 This policy applies to all faculty, staff, students and visitors of the Ross University School of Veterinary Medicine while on campus.

3. PROCEDURE

- 3.1 Only Ross University animals will be permitted to be housed on campus.

All teaching dogs must be kept on leashes when on Campus.

Students, Faculty and Staff are not permitted to have their pets on campus unless they have an appointment at the Community Practice Clinic or there is an emergency. In these cases pets should be taken to the Clinic on a leash or muzzled as necessary. Pets should remain in the Clinic until the owners are ready to take them off campus.

- 1.5 No personal pets are allowed in any buildings (other than the Clinic).
