

# **Student Supply Lists 2017/18**

## **Daycare/PreSchool**

1. Small blanket and pillow for naptime
2. Reusable water bottle with tight seal
3. Box of Band-aids (plain without characters preferred)
4. Change of clothes and 2 pairs of socks (in ziplock bag with child's name on it)
5. Diapers & wipes (if your child is not potty trained)
6. Sunscreen
7. Bib
8. Lunch bag with name on it (send a snack, lunch and drink each day)
9. Backpack
10. Shoes without laces (slip on, Velcro, etc)
11. Sneakers & socks daily

## **PreSchool 2**

1. Small blanket and pillow for naptime
2. Reusable water bottle with tight seal
3. Box of Band-aids (plain without characters preferred)
4. Change of clothes and 2 pairs of socks (in ziplock bag with child's name on it)
5. Sunscreen
6. Lunch bag with name on it (send a snack, lunch and drink each day)  
Please send appropriate cutlery daily  
NOTE: This classroom does not have access to a microwave or a refrigerator
7. Backpack (needs to be large enough to hold a folder)
8. Shoes without laces (slip on, Velcro, etc)
9. Sneakers & socks daily

## **PreK and Kindergarten**

1. Box of Band-aids (plain without characters preferred)
2. Reusable water bottle with tight seal
3. Change of clothes and 2 pairs of socks (in ziplock bag with child's name on it)
4. Sunscreen
5. Lunch bag
6. Backpack (needs to be large enough to hold a folder)
7. Box of 8 markers
8. Box of crayons (24)
9. 2 – Two pocketed folders (plain with no pictures preferred)
10. Sneakers & socks daily

***\*Items might need to be replenished throughout the year. Your child's teacher will advise.***

### **1<sup>st</sup> & 2nd Grade**

1. 1 pack of crayons (24)
2. 1 pack of washable markers (12 or more, fat or thin)
3. 1 pack of colored pencils (12 or more)
4. 24 pencils
5. 5 large erasers
6. Pencil top erasers (optional)
7. 2 small handheld pencil sharpeners that collect the shavings
8. 1 pair of scissors (child size)
9. 1 ruler with centimeters and inches
10. Reusable water bottle with tight seal
11. 7 – Two pocket folders
12. 2 marble primary composition notebooks (all lines)
13. 1 marble primary composition notebook pictures space on top/writing to the bottom
14. “On-ear” headphone (not earbuds)
15. Sunscreen

### **3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Grade**

1. 6 – 2 pocket folders (1 of each: red, yellow, blue, orange – if possible and 2 of any design)
2. 3 composition notebooks
3. 24 pencils (please send mechanical if NOT sending pencil sharpener)
4. Two individual pencil sharpeners with cover
5. 5 erasers
6. 2 packs of wide rule loose leaf paper
7. 1 pair of headphones
8. 1 pack of colored pencils or crayons
9. 1 pack of markers
10. 1 bottle of Elmer’s glue
11. 4 highlighters
12. 1 ruler with centimeters and inches
13. 1 pack of 3 x 5 index cards
14. Socks daily
15. Sunscreen
16. Change of clothes daily for PE & a plastic bag & deodorant to keep in locker

### **5<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> Grade (Binders, folders, dividers and supplies from last year can be reused if in good condition)**

1. 3 – 1& 1/2 inch binders (LA, SS, Sci) **No large binders please!**
2. 2 – ½ inch binders for Foreign Language
3. 5 – two pocket folders
4. 2 packs of dividers (to separate binder sections)
5. Loose-leaf paper (for all classes all year – replenishment will be necessary)
6. Pencils for the year (replenishment is necessary)
7. Erasers
8. Scissors
9. Headphones
10. Change of clothes daily for PE & a plastic bag & deodorant to keep in locker
11. Optional Items: flash drive, colored pencils/markers
