St. Kitts Online Immigration and Customs ED Form and Electronic Travel Authorization – RUSVM Student Instructions

All visitors traveling to St. Kitts from the United States or Canada are required to present a valid passport and an approved Electronic Travel Authorization (eTA).

You can apply for and be approved for an eTA using the mobile app, St Kitts and Nevis e-Border. The app is available for download on Android and iOS devices. If you are unable to use the app, you can complete your eTA at www.knatravelform.kn.

During the application process, you will be asked to do the following:

1. Take a picture or upload a photo of your passport
2. Scan your face with your device
3. Provide information about your trip
4. Answer some questions about yourself
5. Pay for your application

Effective June 2, 2025, visitors who use the mobile app to apply qualify for Fast-Track Arrival via a non-stop contactless Facial Biometric Corridor.

You do not need to complete your application in one go. You can save your progress and complete at a later time, using the same device.

What you need available to complete the application:

- A valid passport for at least six (6) months after your planned date of arrival into St. Kitts and Nevis, with at least one blank page
- Travel and accommodation details
- A payment method - you can use Visa, Mastercard, American Express, JCB, Apple Pay or Google Pay
- Access to your emails (**We recommend using your RUSVM email when submitting your information**)

The eTA application can be submitted up to 90 days before your arrival in St. Kitts. The eTA will be valid for 90 days or until your passport expires, whichever is sooner. A service fee of

US \$8.50 per person applies through August 31, 2025. Effective September 1, 2025, the fee will be US \$17 per person.

In addition to your passport and eTA, please be prepared to show proof of legal name change (for example, a marriage certificate) if applicable, your Enrollment Verification letter which can be accessed through the myRoss portal, and your departing flight information.

Once a new RUSVM student receives their visa stamp in their passport, they no longer need to apply for an eTA for the duration of their approved visa. Also, a departing flight will no longer be necessary when arriving on island from a time away. However, students must continue to complete the Online Immigration and Customs ED Form, which is free of charge. This form is available on the St. Kitts and Nevis e-Border mobile app and on the website at www.knatravelform.kn.
