

Shelter “Rules”

- All occupants must register with the Shelter Manager upon arrival
- **No weapons** and other potential safety hazards
- **No Smoking** in the shelter.
- **No alcohol or other recreational drugs**
- No loud noises or music
- Respect the rights of other shelter occupants
- Pets must be secured on a leash, cornered off or cages and excreta be cleaned immediately
- Address all questions or concerns to the Shelter Manager or Shelter volunteers
- Food will be distributed at assigned times only
- Shelter floors shall be kept clean of all waste materials
- Restrooms shall be kept clean at all times
- Waste containers shall be disposed of as soon as they are filled
- A daily shelter roll call will done for all
- All persons with medical needs must inform the shelter manager
- Occupants shall not leave the shelter until it is advised to do so by Ross Security
- Occupants need to “Check out” with Shelter Manager when advised it is safe to do so and inform Manager of future location
